

**Resolution 2010-11: 36**  
**Technology Request for Proposals**

WHEREAS, the Rochester School Facilities Modernization Program Act (“the Act”) established the Rochester Joint Schools Construction Board (“RJSCB”), a seven voting member board consisting of equal representation by the City of Rochester (“City”) and the Rochester City School District (“District”), as well as a member jointly selected by the City and the District; and

WHEREAS, under the Act, the RJSCB has certain enumerated powers to act as agent for the District, the City, or both; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB, upon the recommendation of its Program Manager, has determined a need for a Technology Consultant to provide a single point of contact for all technology related components that are part of the Rochester Schools Modernization Program, to ensure seamless technology integration in all schools, and to adhere to technology standards as set forth by the District; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB’s MWBE and Services Procurement Committee has reviewed a Request for Proposals for Technology Consultant and approved it for forwarding to the full Board;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Request for Proposals for Technology Consultant is approved for issuance March 1, 2011.
2. The MWBE and Services Procurement Committee is authorized on behalf of the RJSCB to select finalists, conduct interviews as necessary, and recommend to the RJSCB the most qualified candidate.
